UFAW invites applications for its 2012 3Rs PhD Studentship

The Universities Federation for Animal Welfare (UFAW) is inviting applications for its 2012 3Rs Liaison Group Studentship.

The UFAW 3Rs Liaison Group funds research that is likely to lead to practical solutions for advancing the welfare of laboratory animals. The Studentship is to enable a promising graduate, based at a research institute in the British Isles, to undertake a three-year programme of research leading to a degree at the doctorate level in any aspect of the Replacement, Reduction, or Refinement of laboratory animal use, to be awarded in 2012. The award will be for a maximum of £75,000 over the three year period.

UFAW established the 3Rs Liaison Group Research Studentship in 1998 to encourage young scientists to carry out post-graduate studies aimed at improving the welfare of animals used in research. It provides funds for useful and original research that can benefit many animals worldwide. In addition to the direct research benefits, the Studentship has helped to encourage academic interest in this area of animal use.

Since 1998 six Studentships have been awarded. Past students have provided insights into mouse and primate husbandry, and current students are undertaking research to improve the welfare of mice used in cancer research, and on a non-sentient alternative to the use of animals to screen drugs for nausea-inducing side-effects.

Application is a two-stage process with project supervisors initially submitting a brief Concept Note by 14th November 2011.
